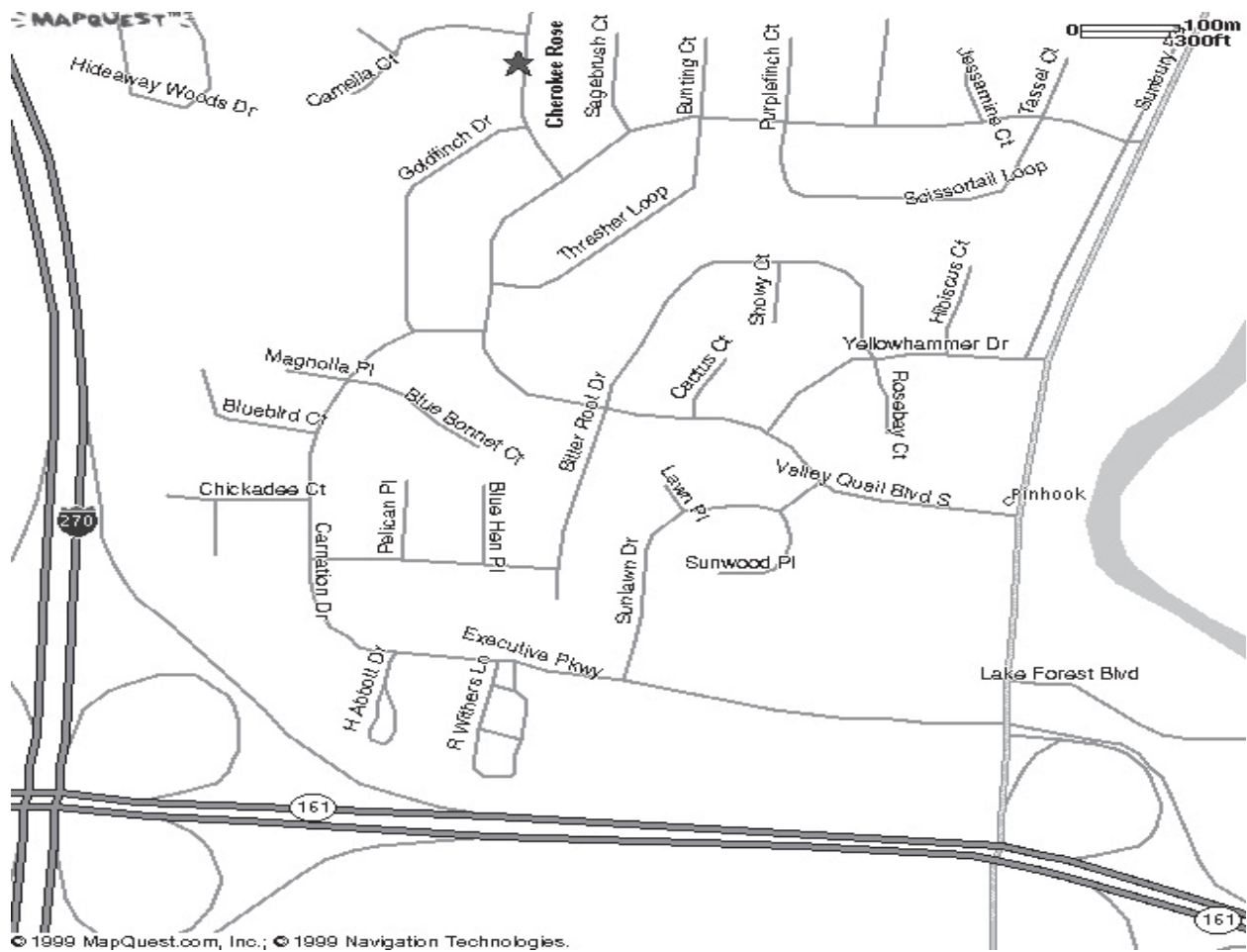

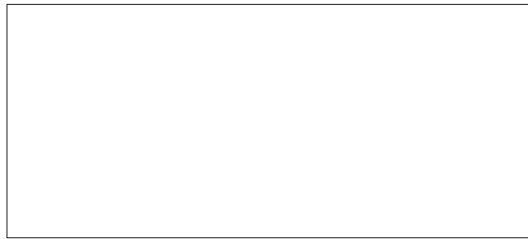
I'll provide burgers and brats or whatever for the grill. Bring a specialty if you have one. Should have a brown, an ESB and a Pilsner on tap. Two keg
