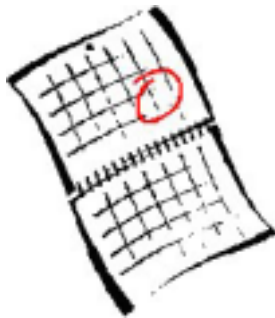

The Winking Lizard

The Winking Lizard Tavern is a new entity on the Columbus beer scene. But, it is not a new company providing very good very drinkable beers to the citizens of Ohio. It was established in 1983 in Bedford Heights, OH, a suburb of Cleveland. They have now expanded to 10 locations and are expecting to expand to a few more locations.

The Columbus Location is on Hutchinson Road in the former location of Dick Clark's Bandstand Grill. (In the area of the Marcus Cinemas off of US 23 and I 270 in Worthington.)

When you enter, you notice how large and spacious the location is. It seems to go on forever. The bar is in front of you and the non smoking area is to the right, separated from the smoking area in the bar by a thick glass wall. On the left side is the check in area and merchandise area. Beyond this, there are two more seating areas, one of them in the old disco that Dick Clark's had. All in all there is a lot of area to put guests.

The food is very well prepared and delicious. If you want to watch sports, there are many televisions all over the restaurant. On the next few pages are the front and back of October's Placemat. As you can see, there are many specials, which change every month.

The bar is large and well stocked with liquor and wine for those that (shudder) don't like beer, or want something different for a change.

The real star of the chain is their beer selection. They have over 100 different types of beer on site and they have some interesting specials and promotions going on.

They have the usual suspects (Bud, Michelob, Miller etc.) but the real stars are the imports and Micro Brews that are all spelled out on the placemat for you (see next pages).

This place is a sports nut and beer geeks heaven. We need to make sure that places like this are patronized by all beer lovers so that we don't wake up to a day when only the usual suspects are served in bars and restaurants in Columbus.

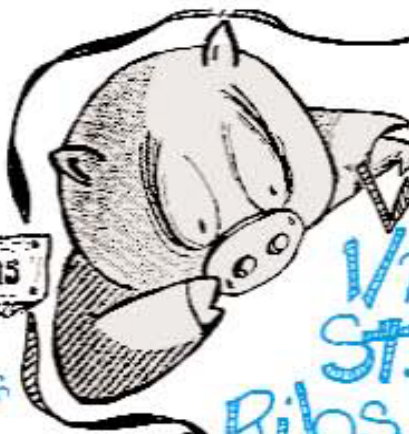

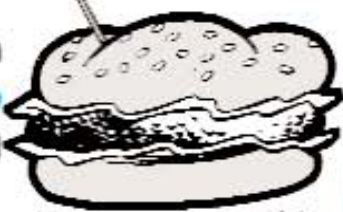
